

**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED RULES
INSPECTION-CHILD LABOR
(Notice 2019-002)**

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

Effective November 19, 2019, the Georgia Department of Labor gives notice that it is withdrawing the proposed rules set forth in Notice 2019-001 and further described below.
