**Emergency Rule 300-2-4-0.22-.13 Maximum Benefit Amount**

In response to the COVID-19 public health emergency, the National Emergency declaration by President Donald Trump on March 13, 2020, the Public Health State of Emergency declared by Governor Brian Kemp on March 14, 2020, and subsequent extensions thereof, under the authority of O.C.G.A. § 34-8-70(i), for claims filed on or after March 14, 2020, the maximum benefits payable to an individual shall be twenty-six times the weekly benefit amount.
