Consider the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) Program

TAA is a federally-funded program designed to support individuals who have lost jobs due to the impacts of foreign trade. If you qualify, you may be eligible for TAA benefits, including:

Training

- ✓ **Classroom/online learning**
(full or part-time)
- ✓ **Certificates**
- ✓ **GED**
(High School Graduate Equivalency Diploma)
- ✓ **ESL**
(English as a Second Language)
- ✓ **College degrees**
- ✓ **On-the-Job Training**
(OJT)

Other Benefits

- ✓ **Individual Career Services**
- ✓ **Job Search Allowance**
(after completion of TAA-approved training)
- ✓ **Relocation Allowance**
(after completion of TAA-approved training)
- ✓ **Travel Reimbursement Allowance**

TAA pays 100% of all full or part-time training costs.
