- ESL (English as a Second Language)
- College degrees
- On-the-Job Training

- Individual Career Services
 - Job Search Allowance (after completion of TAA-approved training)
 - Relocation Allowance (after completion of TAA-approved training)
 - Travel Reimbursement Allowance



TAA pays 100% of all full or part-time training costs.
