Need to gain new skills after a trade-related layoff? Even if you are now working, you may still qualify for benefits that include:

▶ FREE TRAINING

Boost your career with flexible training options—choose from on-the-job-training (OJT) or full or part-time classroom or online settings, full or part-time, to enhance your skills, increase your salary, or start on a new career path. Plus, earn a certificate, diploma, or degree.

TAA covers 100% of all required training expenses including tuition, books, tools, certification fees, and mileage reimbursement for travel over 10 miles one way. Participants may also be eligible receive a laptop and/or internet service for approved training.



▶ JOB SEARCH

Get reimbursed for local and long-distance job search expenses after completing approved training.

▶ RELOCATION

After completion of approved training, TAA may reimburse 90% of relocation expenses for employment 50 miles or more from your current residence.

▶ INDIVIDUAL CAREER SERVICES

Receive personalized guidance to assess your skills, choose the right training, and access resources that boost your salary or help you switch careers, all while upgrading your resume and sharpening your interviewing skills.

▶ SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

TAA can refer you to resources to assist with child and dependent care, transportation, and housing while you train for a new career or re-enter the workforce.



Ask your TAA Representative if you qualify for weekly payments while enrolled in approved training.
